RE: BENEFITS OF UMAFRIKA GAMING TECHNOLOGY'S LATEST BEE CERTIFICATE TO YOUR PROCUREMENT

We take pleasure in presenting to you umAfrika Gaming Technology's latest BEE certificate. We were rated as a **Level 1 Contributor** for the 9th time in 10 years.

South African organisations procuring from us can recognize the following benefits in terms of their BEE procurement scorecard:

1. USE OF UMAFRIKA GAMING TECHNOLOGIES BEE VERIFICATION CERTIFICATE ACROSS TWO FINANCIAL YEARS

Empowerlogic (Pty) Ltd was the BBBEE Verification Agency responsible for the most recent verification of umAfrika Gaming Technologies (Pty) Ltd, certificate **ELC14796RGENBB** issued on **01 July 2026** and set to expire on **30 June 2027**.

This means that an organisation procuring from umAfrika can utilise the certificate **ELC14796RGENBB** at any time during the organisation's financial year, even if the last day of the organisation's audited financial year is after the expiry date OR the issue date of the certificate.

For example,

1. Organisations whose financial year end is on **31 December**, and who procure from umAfrika, will be able to use certificate **ELC14796RGENBB** for their procurement recognition for any procurement from umAfrika **during the organisations' 2026 AND 2027 financial years**.

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2. Organisations whose financial year end is on **31 March** will be able to use certificate **ELC14796RGENBB** for their procurement recognition for any procurement from umAfrika during the organisations' 2026/2027 AND 2027/2028 financial years.

The above same principle would apply to all future certificates issued to umAfrika in June of every year and which expires 12 months later.

The most current certificate is used where more than one was valid in a financial year. The certificate level is applied to the spend for the entire financial year. Current certificate means that the expiry date is not before the commencement date of the financial year.

2. ENHANCED PROCUREMENT RECOGNITION

Amended Generic Codes of 2013 and 2019

umAfrika is a **Level 1 rated company**, as well as being **at least 51% Black Owned**. Therefore, you can multiply your umAfrika invoiced spend by **162%** to arrive at your BEE procurement score for procuring from us if you are rated against the Amended Generic Codes of 2013 and 2019.

This is because, according to the Amended Generic Codes, your weighted BEE procurement spend from umAfrika, already multiplied by 135%, can be multiplied further by a factor of 1.2 for procuring from companies that have at least 51% Black Ownership.

Amended Tourism B-BBEE Sector Code (20 November 2015)

As a Level 1 rated company, you can multiply your umAfrika invoiced spend by **135%** to arrive at your BEE procurement score for procuring from us if you are rated against the Amended Tourism B-BBEE Sector Code (20 November 2015).
